

# Battery is broken English

What does it mean when a battery dies?

This comes from the phrase "The battery died" or describing batteries as dead when they are out of power, which entered common speech before most batteries were rechargeable, when a battery running out of power was functionally the same as it being broken. Saying an object has "died" can also mean that it is broken, usually beyond repair.

What is the difference between a dead battery and a broken battery?

To distinguish between dead - a flat battery (fixable) and a broken, it is common to refer to the latter case as "bricked". In other words it is as useful as a brick for making phone calls. But as others have commented, died /dead can mean either depending on the circumstances. This is a common phrase and can mean both things.

One of those challenges is recognising a broken or damaged battery, especially because it is sometimes not visible from the outside that something is wrong inside. When you put a defective battery on the charger, it can catch fire. This can lead to a very intense battery fire with toxic smoke gases being released.

What happens if you don't dispose of batteries?
