

Lead-acid battery warranty for one year and then replaced with a new one

What is the warranty on Exide Batteries?

The label on every Exide battery specifies the total number of months covered by the free replacement period and the Pro-Rata period for batteries fitted in private cars, multi-utility vehicles*, two-wheelers, inverters, gensets and solar applications. In all cases the warranty is applicable from the date of sale to the original purchaser.

When does a battery warranty start?

For a battery being replaced on Free of Cost basis the warranty commences from the date of sale of the original batteryas stated in the original Invoice and not from the date of replacement given. For batteries purchased on pro-rata warranty settlement discount, a fresh warranty is applicable from the date of purchase.

Are batteries covered by a warranty?

Batteries used in a commercial or professional application, such as taxis, driving instructors, emergency services, works vehicles, etc., are not covered by the full term of the warranty but instead come with a 6 month warranty. How does the guarantee work? The guarantee covers any manufacturing defects which arise within the guarantee period.

Is a car battery warranty transferable?

Your car battery guarantee isn't transferablebetween vehicles. Batteries used in a commercial or professional application, such as taxis, driving instructors, emergency services, works vehicles, etc., are not covered by the full term of the warranty but instead come with a 6 month warranty. How does the guarantee work?

Do Yuasa Batteries have a warranty?

Battery Warranty All Yuasa automotive batteries are covered by a one year warranty. The warranty covers faults caused by a manufacturing defect or material failure - it does not cover non manufacturing issues related to misuse, physical damage, wear &tear or severely discharged batteries.

Does a new battery need to be coded?

If you replace the old battery with a new battery that is the same type &category and the same specs (same amp hour...ie an H8/49 AGM 92 AH battery for a 90-95AH AGM H8 battery) then no...the new battery will NOT need to be "coded". BUT any replacement battery will ALWAYS need to be REGISTERED (as explained by mattmar1).

To make sure everything goes as planned when switching out for a new battery, one should follow these instructions carefully or reach out to an expert if uncertain about ...
